## Jade's snowflake dance

Snowflake Dance- Kids play out the dance as you read the story of how the flakes form and drift down, then get moved along the snow surface. I used a drum to simulate the exciting storm or slow, slow, snowflakes floating down.

"You start as a speck of dust in the sky – start out all curled up and small. Begin moving around with your arms against your sides. Water vapour forms on you and you grow extensions of ice – lift up your arms and kick out your legs. When you get too big, you start to dance and collide with others – link arms – and when you get too heavy you float to the

ground. Lie down and become part of the snowpack- the soft blanket of snow that covers the ground. ..When the wind picks up it breaks off your extensions and you roll around like a ball and collide with others to form snow drifts or pile — make a big snow pile. Sometimes you bounce as you are picked up by the wind...and twirl around....Finally, you come to rest again, lying there waiting for the next layer of snow crystals to join you as the snowpack becomes a thicker and thicker white blanket for the winter landscape....
